For someone experiencing domestic abuse the workplace may be one of the safest spaces for them to seek help.

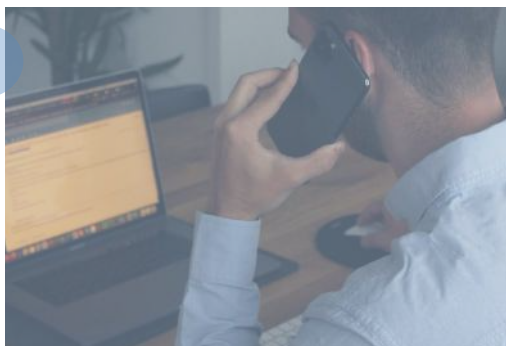
