To lead, support and facilitate the team of Empowering Systems Change Complex Needs Workers, the referral process and team meetings in addition to carrying and supporting a caseload of services users and to support the WLL Projects Manager in the mainstreaming/refunding of the Complex Needs Service by providing and presenting both internally and externally to others information to achieve this.
